- Land Rights Inquiry has been conducted for 15 municipalities : Msunduzi, Big Five Hlabisa, Mandeni, Mthonjaneni, Dr Nkosazane Dlamini-Zuma, Edumbe, Umvoti, Okhahlamba, uPhongola, Impendle, Dannhouser, Umuziwabantu, Ulundi, Newcastle & Alfred Duma
- 10 Layout Plans and Occupancy Table were developed where applicable.
- Draft Working Plan for 15 towns to be completed before the 31st of March 2019.
- 15 Municipalities has been identified for 2019/2020 Financial Year in terms of Provincial Spatial Economic Development Strategy (PSEDS)
