SUB-COMMITTEE 1

- Amendments to SPLUMA
- Proposed amendments up to land for parks and open spaces (section 50)
- Resume with internal appeals on 19 September
- Much more frame work legislation
 - Example: Tribunals
 - No references to joint tribunals
 - No requirement of outside persons on tribunal
 - Municipality can decide how many member must decide an application

SUB-COMMITTEE 2

- Exchange of provincial legislation
- Review and comment on provincial legislation
 - Best practice
 - Avoid pitfalls
- Identify laws that require alignment
 - Example: Joint public consultation process
 - Mining application
 - Environmental impact authorisation
 - Zoning application

SUB-COMMITTEE 3

- Identify laws that require rationalisation
 - Laws that give an authority, other than the municipality, the right to determine land use
 - Example: Land reform legislation
 - Laws that appear to give an authority, other than the municipality, the right to determine land use
 - World heritage legislation
 - Coastal management legislation
